

Spirals and the Vortex

The Earth's rotation causes all fluids and gases to move in spirals. Water's spiralling is familiar because it is the more visible. But you can see it with smoke and sometimes with mists. Spirals are a basic form of motion in Nature, but Viktor Schauberger in the 1930s recognized the vortex as the principal creative movement system in the Universe. It is at the core of his eco-technology and the condition required to produce the vortex is turbulence, or chaotic motion.

James Gleick, who popularised the ideas of chaos theory in the early 1980s, pointed out that life is created from chaos. Fluids are the ideal media of chaos because of their unpredictable and turbulent behaviour. Water turbulence creates vortices and spirals in an energetic stream, with the flow direction constantly changing from left to right.

From the tornado to the way a plant grows, the vortex is Nature's mechanism for increasing the quality of energy from a lower to a higher level. It is a powerful tool for evolution, and perhaps water's most constructive role is to use the vortex for this purpose.

Ilya Prigogine saw that disorder creates simultaneously stable and unstable oscillating systems that are spiral-form in structure leading to order. This oscillation enables a dynamic homeostasis (stability) to exist, and to increase complexity and energy levels. This mirrors Schauberger's practical research in how a stream raises energy levels, which he applied to his eco-technological applications. Prigogine sees the vortex as energy dissipating, in line with Schauberger's view.

The vortex is a window between different qualities or levels of energy. Black holes can be thought of as vortices, gateways linking different parts of our universe or even different universes. The vortex and spiral have become hallmarks for Viktor Schauberger, as for him they were the key to all creative movement. The vortex is most clearly seen with water, which it uses as vortical motion to purify and energize itself, introducing finer etheric energies to wipe clean the bad energies of the water's previous memory of misuse.

One could use the image of a musty room that feels stale and unwelcoming. Once sunlight and fresh air are allowed to penetrate, the unpleasant atmosphere is quickly transformed. It is a natural principle that more refined energy will always prevail over the coarser. As Viktor Schauberger demonstrated, Nature's evolutionary 'purpose' is continually to refine and to create greater complexity and diversity, the vortex being the key process in this endeavour.

Raising Energy with Two Eggs

The egg is the only shape that will encourage liquids to self-circulate spirally, which is the way they retain their energy level, otherwise they go flat and lifeless. It is for this reason that Nature uses the egg to nurture new life.

Water is the source, the container and the maintainer of life. In order to do this, our biological water and blood flow spirally in our bodies, doing their work of carrying nutrients and facilitating complex communications between organs and metabolic systems.

The double egg vortexer is an ingenious device that optimizes the particular energy-raising qualities of the egg to produce living water. With the pointy end down, the top egg is briskly rotated alternately clockwise (creating a positive charge) and anti-clockwise (a negative charge), the alternating polarities raising the energy at each change of direction. The water mass in the upper egg

expands its energy and forces the vortexing water chaotically through the narrow neck. As the water falls into the lower egg, pointy end up, the resulting turbulence creates balanced energy, restructuring it at a higher energy level, drawing the energy inwards.

As in so many of Nature's processes, we see here the electromagnetic principle at work, where there is a rhythmic oscillation between positive and negative charges, which in water's case both maintains and can raise its energy level.

The whole water body is rotated in the egg as a cohesive mass which optimises its restructuring. The double egg vortexer, separating the two processes of expansion (yang) from concentration (yin) means that the re-energising is more complete and more efficient than any other means of doing this.

This dual system elegantly combines the energy dissipating function of the vortex with the energy enhancing mode of chaos in the lower egg. The natural egg shape, based on sacred geometry (*phi*), in each case encourages the water body to circulate efficiently as a coherent whole. The natural coherence of water is amplified by the egg shape, helping it break through into the quantum domain, from which it can absorb higher quality subtle energies. Quantum coherence is much more dynamic than normal physical coherence.
